### **GPP Minor Declaration Instructions**

Students interested in pursuing the Global Poverty and Practice Minor should complete this entire form, which includes the following:

- The semesters in which you plan to complete the core courses and practice experience for the Minor
- The **course numbers and titles** of two potential courses you may enroll in to fulfill each of the two elective requirements. Note that the elective courses should be relevant to the region and sector of your intended practice experience. The list of approved elective courses can be downloaded from the GPP Minor Requirements Page.
- Brief responses to questions regarding what type of Practice Experience (PE) you are seeking.
  We don't require that you have decided what you will be doing for your PE to declare the
  Minor. Your responses to these questions will help us advise you regarding potential options
  for your PE. Further discussion about the Practice Experience will take place during your
  Declaration Orientation.

#### **Submitting the Declaration of Intent form:**

The declaration deadline for Fall 2016 is **Wednesday**, **October 5**<sup>th</sup> and the deadline for Spring 2017 is **Wednesday**, **March 8**<sup>th</sup>. The Declaration of Intent form must be submitted in person to a GPP Advisor during the following drop-in advising hours:

Monday, Wednesday: 10:00am - 12:00pm; 1:30pm - 4:00pm

Tuesday, Thursday: 1:30pm - 4:00pm

Friday: 10:00am - 12:00pm

When submitting the declaration form, students will meet with a GPP Advisor for 5-10 minutes to discuss their responses to the questions on the form. Students are encouraged to submit their declaration of intent form at least one week in advance of this deadline to avoid long lines in the advising office.

After submitting this form, students will be invited to attend a GPP Declaration Orientation session. Attendance at one of the orientation sessions is required to complete the declaration process.
